


THE FUTURE

Just as in Sanskrit, where the future of some roots is formed by adding -iṣya-, and of others by adding -sya-, so too in Prakrit there are two ways of forming the future stem:

- Adding -issa-.
- Adding -ha-.

The future in -issa-
