Perfect – Numbers

Give the requested form of **five out of six** of the following verbal roots. Also provide a **subject** for each verb, using a **nominative** form of the number appropriate to the verb form (e.g., “one” for singular, “two” for dual, and anything else for plural), in a gender of your choice.

1. वि-√जि 1 *ātmanē*. “conquer”: 3rd person singular *perfect* (लिट्)¹

एको/एका विजिग्ये

2. √सेव् 1 *ātmanē*. “serve”: 3rd person dual *perfect* (लिट्)²

द्वौ/द्वे सिषेवाते

3. √अह *parasmai*. “say”: 3rd person singular *perfect* (लिट्)

एक आह / एकाह

4. √गम् 1 *parasmai*. “go”: 3rd person plural *perfect* (लिट्)

त्रयो / तिस्रो जग्मुः

5. √वस् 1 *parasmai*. “reside”: 2nd person plural *perfect* (लिट्)

यूयं चतुर / चतस्र ऊष

6. √स्था 1 *parasmai*. “stand”: 3rd person singular *perfect* (लिट्)

एकस्तस्थौ / एका तस्थौ

1 By 7.3.57, we have a *velar* instead of a *palatal* in the root syllable of √जि in the perfect.

2 Remember that roots with long vowels followed by consonants never take any vowel gradation (e.g., √जीव्, √सेव्, √क्रीड्).
