

# The king gives money to the teacher from the treasury in the palace.

## In the ACTIVE VOICE (कर्तरि प्रयोगः)

we select the *agent* as the *subject* of the verb, and assign the *case endings* accordingly.

नृपः · दुर्दाति · धेनम् · आचार्याय · कोशात् · प्रासादे ·

"give" is transitive (सकर्मकः) so the verb takes the patient as an **object** in the accusative case.

## In the PASSIVE VOICE (कर्मणि प्रयोगः)

we select the *patient* as the *subject* of the verb, and assign the *case endings* accordingly.

धनम् - दत्तम् - नृपेण - आचार्याय - कोशात् - प्रासादे -

"give" is transitive (सकर्मकः) so the participle in -ta- automatically agrees with the patient (कर्म).
